ONE TWELVE GALLERY PRESENTS *REVERIES*



Atlanta, Ga. — One Twelve Gallery in the Stove Works of Inman Park presents ***Reveries***, an exhibition of mixed media works by artist Linda Mitchell.

Mitchell, a native of Atlanta, received her MFA from Georgia State in 1994. She has been exhibiting her paintings and sculptures locally and nationally for over 20 years.

Many of Mitchell's works feature animals prominently, often in surreal or dreamlike settings. Each piece tells a story, delving into Mitchell's own memories and our own collective life experiences.

In her most recent work, Mitchell creates layered, multidimensional pieces using recycled and reclaimed materials. One series pairs colored glass with found objects. Paintings, drawings, photos, bits of fabric or plant materials are placed between layers of colored glass, creating an interplay between lucid and obscure. These pieces hint at what lies beneath the scarred, time-worn surface of a person or an object. Time takes its inevitable toll, but beauty and meaning remain.

Reveries opens Friday, November 18 with an artists' reception from 7 to 9 pm that is free and open to the public. The show runs through January 29, 2012.
