May 30, 2011 — ATLANTA, Ga. — One Twelve Gallery in the Stove Works of Inman Park presents *Textures*, abstract paintings by two artists.

Donna Johnson is a psychotherapist and artist who was born and raised in the Southeast and currently lives in Atlanta. Johnson earned her BFA from the University of Tennessee and her MA from Savannah College of Art and Design, where she focused on encaustic painting.

Johnson brings together her dual passions of art and psychotherapy to explore themes of spiritual and psychological transformation in her work.

Marietta resident Barbara Rehg received her BFA from Webster College in St. Louis and spent many years running a printing business with her husband. She now devotes all her time to watercolor-based painting, which she fell in love with in college, and she uses watercolors in non-traditional ways to create vibrant abstract compositions on canvas.

Abstract art is often a pure representation of an artist's emotions, and its purpose is to provoke emotion in the viewer. The paintings in *Textures*, though quite different in subject matter, each employ texture and color to invoke this visceral reaction.

Textures opens Friday, June 17 with an artists' reception from 7 to 9 pm that is free and open to the public. The show will run through August 21, 2011.
