ONE TWELVE GALLERY PRESENTS *ONE*: IMAGES OF ISOLATION



July 13, 2010 — ATLANTA, Ga. — One Twelve Gallery in the Stove Works of Inman Park presents *One*, photography by Emily Dryden, Joe Martinez and Aaron Pevey.

A recent transplant to New York City, Emily Dryden worked as a freelance photographer in Atlanta after graduating from Portfolio Center. She has shot for Kroger, Point 3 Basketball, Arm-chair Media and New Uniform Design, and her work has appeared in *Atlanta Magazine* and *CMYK*.

Joe Martinez grew up in a Navy family and lived all over the world before graduating in photography from Atlanta's Portfolio Center and settling in nearby East Point to freelance. He has worked with Nickelodeon, Yahoo! Music, and *Atlanta Magazine*, among others.

Aaron Pevey, whose work is pictured above, lives and photographs in Atlanta. The prints in *One* he shot with vintage cameras and developed both digitally and on 120 film. He uses all-plastic cameras because, he says, "they bend light in interesting, unexpected ways."

Each image in *One*—whether portrait, still-life, interior or landscape—suggests a sense of isolation that often inhabits the city dweller, for better or worse.

One will begin Friday, August 20th with an artists' reception from 7:00 to 9:00 pm that is free and open to the public. The show will run through October 22nd, 2010.
